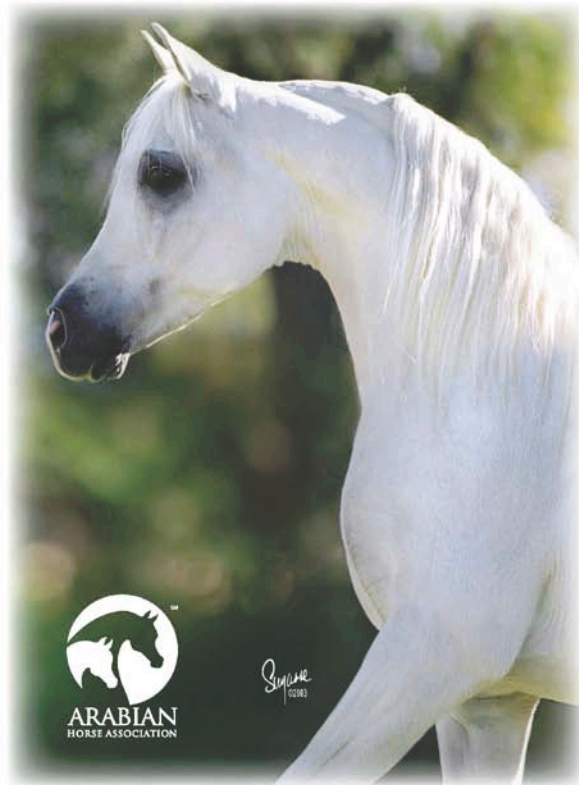

ALL ENTRY BLANKS MUST HAVE THE OWNER'S SOCIAL SECURITY OR FEDERAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER AND COMPLETE MAILING ADDRESS.

COLORADO REQUIRES A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST DATED NO MORE THAN ONE (1) YEAR FROM DATE OF ARRIVAL AND A HEALTH CERTIFICATE DATED NO MORE THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS FROM DATE OF ARRIVAL ON ALL OUT-OF-STATE HORSES.

## **ENTRY RULES**

**DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS FEES:** All horses entering any recognized USEF show will be charged \$7.00 per horse for Drugs and Medications, plus a \$8.00 USEF fee.

**ENTRIES CLOSE JUNE 22, 2010** and must be postmarked on or before that date. Payment must accompany entry. After that date, a Post Entry Fee of \$5.00 per class will be charged.

All entries must be made on the official Entry form. A copy of the registration papers for each horse entered and copies of AHA and USEF membership cards for each owner, rider/driver/handler and trainer are required with the Entry form. Those without current AHA and USEF cards are subject to non-member fees as listed on the Fees page.

Entry forms must be signed by the owner or agent, trainer, and rider/driver/handler, and have complete addresses. If owner and trainer are the same, owner must sign in both places.

Only **one owner** per Entry form. Photocopies of Entry form are acceptable. No horse may be entered on another owner's Entry form.

**POST ENTRIES:** Post entries for other than Championship classes will be accepted at the regular entry fee, plus \$5.00 per class.

No Post Entry fee for Championships, Lead Line, Walk/Trot/Jog, or AHA Medal classes.

**REFUNDS:** No refund will be made after entry closing date without a veterinarian certificate. The certificate must be received in the Show Office prior to the end of the show. The office fee of \$20.00 is **not** refundable. Once the horse is on the show grounds, the official show veterinarian must certify any vet out. No refunds for scratched classes.

## **GENERAL RULES**

**AGE OF HORSE AND RIDER:** Horse's age shall be determined as of January 1. Rider's age shall be as of December 1 throughout the following show season.

**AHA:** Exhibitors at this show will qualify for Region 8, Youth Nationals, U.S. Nationals and Canadian Nationals Championship shows, according to the current AHA Handbook.

**INTERNATIONAL ARABIAN BREEDERS SWEEPSTAKES:** Classes are open to ALL horses regardless if they are sweepstakes horses or not. \$ before class description denotes a sweepstakes class.

**CONDUCT:** Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider or driver of any horse on exhibition will disqualify such horse from adjudication, and the owner shall forfeit his/her entries and other fees.

**REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** (GR 1509) In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from the Federation, a Licensed Competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior at a Licensed Competition or towards its management, which management is able to substantiate, or previous unsportsmanlike behaviors at a Licensed Competition which management is able to substantiate.

**PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) in any division or class without penalty from the judge.

**HOOF RULE:** Horses less than two years of age must be shown barefoot.

**IN GATE:** The In Gate will be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring for a class. If classes are very small, the Summertime Celebration Horse Show reserves the right to extend gate holds.

**PROTESTS:** Any protest must be made in accordance with the USEF rules governing protests. See current USEF Rule Book.

**REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS:** Purebred Arabians must have been issued a Certificate of Registration from the Arabian Horse Association, and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or be eligible for registration and have registration applied for.

Half-Arabians must have been issued a Certificate of Registration from the Arabian Horse Association, or be eligible for registration and have registration applied for. Horses are to be entered and shown under their full registered names.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** The membership of the Half-Arabian, Arabian and Amateur Association of Colorado, the management of the Summertime Celebration Horse Show, and the Boulder County Fairgrounds will not be held responsible for any loss or destruction of any equipment or property not owned by them, or for any damages to or by any animal.

### **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. (See GR901.9 of the Federation Rule Book)

**AMATEUR CERTIFICATION:** Every person who has reached his/her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification, which must be renewed annually, will expire on November 30<sup>th</sup> and must be available for inspection, or the competitor must have lodged with the show secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation.

**AHA MEMBERSHIP:** All non-members owning horses entered in the show must pay a single event membership fee of **\$30.00 per person**. Single Event Members shall only have exhibiting privileges for the duration of the event where the membership is purchased. Any owner, trainer, driver, rider or handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individuals or horses at the show, must be a competition member of AHA or pay a single event fee of **\$30.00 per person**. (Exception: Exhibitors entered in Walk/Trot classes and Leadline shall be exempt from paying the AHA non-member fees). **Associate Cards DO NOT allow for competition privileges. Membership must include a valid COMPETITION CARD or pay the \$35.00 single event fee.**

**AHA MEDAL CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:**

**AHA Saddle Seat Medal Class:**

Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers are not to be used. For a medal to be awarded, three competitors with proper appointments must compete.

**AHA Reining Seat Medal Class:**

All contestants are required to perform a reining pattern as outlined in U.S. Equestrian Federation RN107, or EC equivalent. Other tests may be included from USEF Reining or EC equivalent. Dropping of bits is optional with the judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits. In an AHA Reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon. The prescribed AHA Reining Score Sheet must be used and posted in accordance with USED rule AR199.5. Numbers must be worn on the rider's back or on the left side of the saddle pad and must be clearly visible at all times when in competition. For a medal to be awarded, three competitions with proper appointments must compete.

**AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal class:**

Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF AR217 1-4 & subchapter 2 (EQ113) Markers not to be used. For a medal to be awarded, three competitors with proper appointments must compete

**AHA Western Horsemanship Medal class:**

Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR224.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devised for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**USE OF WHIPS:** Cruelty to or the abuse of a horse by any person at any recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, show ring, schooling area or elsewhere on the show grounds, before or during a show by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty. No item disturbing to other entries may be used inside or outside the ring while showing a horse, except on whip per handler, no longer than six (6) feet, including the snapper. No lashes or appendages of any kind are permitted. Harness classes are excepted. The judge has the responsibility to excuse from the ring any horse that has whip marks or other evidence of cruelty.

**GROUND RULES**

**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** No alcoholic beverages may be consumed on the show grounds.

**ARENAS:** The competition arena is an indoor 100' x 200' arena with a sand/dirt mix footing. The warm-up arena is an outdoor 100' x 100' arena with a sand/dirt mix footing.

**CAMPER HOOKUPS:** Camper hookups are available on a first come basis in the Boulder County Campground. Exhibitors must make space reservations with the campground office. Please call 303-678-1525 for rates and reservations. All camper fees will be collected by the campground.

**DOGS:** Dogs must be on leashes at all times and will not be allowed in the grandstand area.

**FARRIER:** A farrier will be available on the show grounds during all scheduled sessions.

**FIRST AID:** An EMT will be available during all scheduled sessions. For emergency call 911.

**FOOD SERVICES:** Food services will be available on the show grounds.

**PARKING:** Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse vans and trailers. Only these specific areas will be used for parking.

**PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM:** The public address system is considered a courtesy to the exhibitors and its function or coverage to all areas cannot be guaranteed. No protest will be upheld or refunds made solely because of sound system inadequacy or failure. It is the exhibitors responsibility to be aware of the show progress and be ready for their class(es).

**STALLS AND TACK STALLS:** Stalls and Tack Stalls will be assigned on a first come first serve basis with paid horse entries. Those who wish to stall together are requested to submit their entries in the same envelope. If the entries arrive separately, the stall assignment will be based on the latest entry received. Stalls are permanent, have full doors, are matted and are 12 x 12. Stalls will be available Friday, July 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m., and must be vacated by Sunday night, July 11<sup>th</sup> or there will be an additional charge. If you plan to arrive before Friday evening or stay after Sunday night, arrangements must be made with Boulder County Fairgrounds (303) 678-6235, and fees paid directly to the Fairgrounds.

Stalls for post entered horses cannot be guaranteed.

**NON-STALLED HORSE GROUNDS FEE:** Those exhibitors showing horses without a stall will be charged a grounds fee of \$15.00 per horse, per show day. All horses must be stalled if on the show grounds overnight.

**VETERINARIAN:** A local veterinarian will be on call July 11, 2010. Charges will be made to the person requesting services for treatment received.
